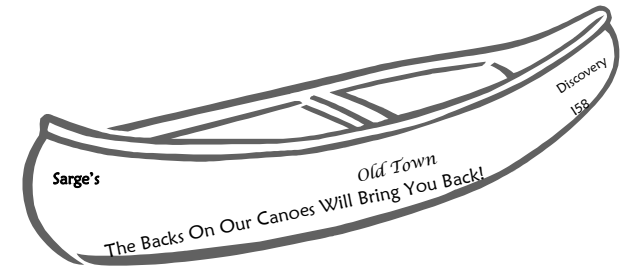

## West Pigeon River Trips

THESE TRIPS REQUIRE A PICK UP TIME! And you must portage at the Nasby Dam if you are continuing on to Ontario. After you've picked your river trip you designate a time to be picked up from your ending destination. You take off from Sarge's and float/paddle downriver to your destination and are picked up at the pre-determined pick up time.
